AgSafe is a statewide non-profit organization dedicated to providing employers and employees in the agricultural industry with education and resources to prevent injuries, illnesses and fatalities.

### Wage, Hour, Health and Safety Training

January 10, 2019

### First Aid/CPR Training

First Aid/CPR AgSafe is a Medic First Aid Training Center and provides an agricultural specific First Aid/CPR course, good for 2-years and in compliance with state regulations specific to employee first aid training requirements. This course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge necessary to respond to an emergency and perform first aid treatment, including CPR for adults.

#### **HAZ-MAT CLASS**

Two classes will be offered

This class is for farmers & farm employees who need to renew their DL-267 endorsement or acquire an initial endorsement. The Butte County Farm Bureau is offering an Agricultural Hazardous Materials Transportation Program.

This class is for persons **21 years or older**, who have a current **California** class C driver's license. Students will receive a DL-267 certificate that will enable them to legally transport hazardous agricultural materials on public roadways, (within a 50 mile radius) without a commercial driver's license. Class participants must have a valid and current California driver's license with them to participate in this class.

The credits earned in this class are valid for 4 years.

## **Heat Illness Prevention Training & Sexual Harassment Prevention Training** *February 6, 2019*

\$40 Per Person

**Heat Illness Prevention Training** - This workshop will investigate the fundamentals of a successful heat illness prevention plan, practices which lead to behavior change and application, and take a look at success stories from within the industry. It will also cover the most recent additions to the heat standard, including mandatory breaks for employees and the implications to wage and hour laws.

**Sexual Harassment Prevention Training** - This training meets the requirements of AB 1825 and AB 2053 which requires all supervisorial employees to be trained in sexual harassment prevention for at least two hours every two years and annually for Farm Labor Contractor Supervisors. It will cover practical information and guidance regarding federal and state regulations, prevention, and correction remedies of sexual harassment in the workplace while covering the requirements of an anti-harassment and abusive conduct policy.
