Applicant Requirements:

- 2.5 GPA
- Butte County High School Senior Graduate
- Applicant must be enrolled in an agriculture major or in an agriculture related trade school program like Mechanics, Welding, etc.

Application must include the following:

- Picture of Applicant
- Two Letters of Recommendation (One of the two letters must be from a school faculty member)
- Scholarship Resume
- A copy of high school transcripts
- A typed 1-page essay describing yourself and your future educational goals in agriculture.
- Contact information (email, mailing address, phone number)

Scholarship Amount: Dependent upon applicant.

Deadline:

- All applications are due by March 27, 2026 (Postmarked by March 27 will be accepted)

In Person Interviews:

- Scholarship finalists will need to attend an in-person interview that will be conducted at the end of April or in the first week of May.
